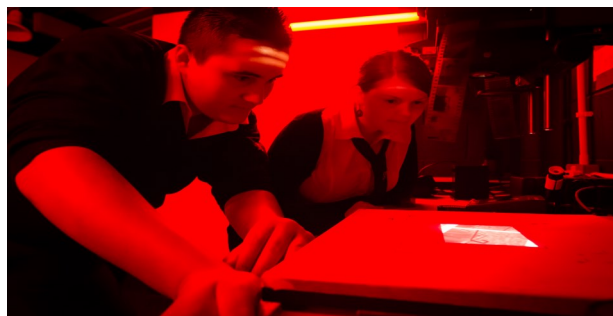

All units within this qualification are assessed internally

A summative unit grade can be awarded at pass, merit or distinction

To achieve a 'pass' a learner must have satisfied **all** the pass assessment criteria

To achieve a 'merit' a learner must additionally have satisfied **all** the merit grading criteria

To achieve a 'distinction' a learner must additionally have satisfied **all** the distinction grading criteria

Learners who complete the unit but who do not meet all the pass criteria are graded 'unclassified'.
