Why study for a Level 3 Certificate in Child Care and Education?

Candidates may progress to higher level qualifications, as the CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Child Care and Education carries UCAS tariff points, graded up to a maximum of 120 points. An A grade is equivalent to the maximum tariff points that can be achieved from an 'A' level. The course may be completed in a year. Having gained the Certificate you may be able to progress into nursing, teaching or other areas of Higher Education, subject to individual university and college entry criteria. Examples of job roles: Nursery assistant; Pre-school leader; Playgroup leader; Special educational needs supporter.

What does the course contain?

Duration of Diploma programme: 1 year

All assignments and the short answer paper must be passed to gain the full qualification.

You must complete Units 1 - 5 and a short answer paper.
