  - Bydd y ffreutur ar agor i ddarparu bwyd poeth ac oer
  - Dylai disgyblion wisgo gwisg ysgol lawn (Gwisg tymor y Gaeaf - crys a thei yn hytrach na chrys polo)
  - Dylai disgyblion wisgo gwisg ymarfer corff / chwaraeon i'r ysgol ar y diwrnodau pan mae'r gwersi yna ar yr amserlen
- Dydd Mawrth, Tachwedd 3<sup>ydd</sup> - Bl 9 i Bl 13
  - Dysgu o adref yn dechrau am 4 diwrnod
  - Bydd darpariaeth byw dros Teams i'r holl ddisgyblion. Bydd y ddarpariaeth yma'n cynnwys amrywiaeth o ffrydio byw, cyfarwyddiadau wedi recordio a chyfarwyddyd dros Teams. Bydd athrawon yn cefnogi disgyblion trwy'r wers ac yn gallu ateb cwestiynau dros Teams. Ni fydd athrawon yn cyflwyno am wersi cyfan. Bydd gwersi yn amrywio rhwng cyfnodau o gyfarwyddyd gan athro a chyfnodau tawel er mwyn i ddisgyblion gwblhau tasgau. Mae'n debygol mewn rhai gwersi bydd disgyblion eisoes yn gwybod beth fydd eu tasgau - mae athrawon wedi bod paratoi disgyblion ac yn esbonio tasgau ar gyfer y cyfnod clo i ddisgyblion yn ystod yr wythnos hon.

Dear Parent / Carer,

You will be aware of the recent announcement by the Welsh Government. Wales is entering a short lockdown and this will affect Welsh secondary schools. Below you will find information about our arrangements for this period.

- Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup> - Friday 30<sup>th</sup>; Half term for pupils and staff. School closed
- Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> - Inset Training Day. School closed for pupils
- Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> - Years 7 and 8
  - School resumes for all Year 7 and 8 pupils and pupils in Canolfan y Môr and Canolfan Croeso
  - All bus and taxi services will continue to run
  - The canteen will be open to provide hot and cold food
  - Pupils should wear full school uniform (Winter term uniform - shirt and tie rather than polo shirt)
  - Pupils should wear PE / school uniform to school on the days when those lessons are on the timetable
- Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup> - Yr 9 to Yr 13
  - Learning from home starting for 4 days
  - There will be Teams provision for all pupils with a 'live' element to all lessons. This provision will include a variety of live streaming, recorded instructions and instruction over Teams. Teachers will support pupils throughout the lesson and will be able to answer questions by using posts on Teams. Teachers will not be 'presenting' for whole lessons. Lessons will vary between periods of teacher instruction and quiet periods for pupils to complete tasks. It is likely that in some lessons pupils will already know what their tasks will be - teachers have been preparing pupils and explaining tasks for the lockdown period to pupils this week
  - Pupils are expected to 'join' each lesson during the lockdown and follow their timetables. Pupils' 'attendance' at lessons will be recorded. Where siblings within the home share a

device to access Teams, they should access half the lesson to gain access to the teachers' instructions and use the remainder to complete work in their books, files, booklets or past exam papers.

- Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11 pupils will have a full day of 5 lessons, the first starting at 9.00am. Break and lunch will remain during the normal times; the school day ends at 3.15. The number of lessons that Year 12 and 13 have will vary according to their timetable but they are expected to work during non-contact lessons and complete extra school work after 3.15pm as in any school week.

- Monday, November 9<sup>th</sup>

- School open to all
- All rules and arrangements to protect against Covid-19 remain
