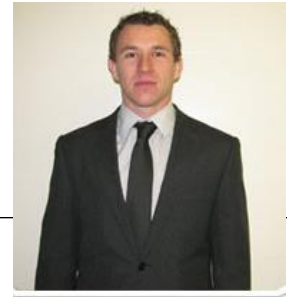

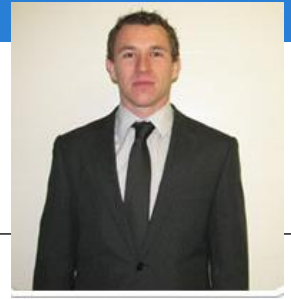

Interview with Mrs Anwen Davies

After 23 years of teaching in the school and previously as a pupil the time has come to farewell with Mrs Anwen Davies. We asked her some questions.

Do you remember your first day as a teacher in Ysgol Gyfun Aberaeron?

Yes, I remember sharing a lift with Dr Snow (it was also her first day) and parking the car up on the top yard and feeling very nervous. I remember thinking that everyone was looking at us. Then having a shock to see that the school was like a building site- all the labs were in a mobile cabin.

Favourite school trip?

Back in 1986, I had just finished my O Level exams (equivalent to GCSE) and I went with the school to Venice in Italy. This was Mr Richard Griffiths' first trip and the Headmaster, Mr Dai Thomas (or Twm Chem) came with us. We were all excited to stay in a hotel in the middle of Venice. Fantastic memories! One of the memories that stays in the mind is when Mrs Davies, Head of Biology, fell out of her gondola!

Favourite school dinner?

Beef dinner or cawl.

What's the worst thing that has happened to you in the lab?

A year 13 experiment in 2000. When I was standing next to one group I asked them to turn down the temperature of the Bunsen Burner. I then noticed white gas coming out of the equipment and suddenly the glass exploded and the acid shot up to the ceiling covering some of the pupils and a girl's new coat. We had to put lots of water over the pupils and I offered to pay for the girl's coat. Luckily everyone was fine. As a result the Science department bought new white coats for the labs and hooks to hang the coats!!!



What will you miss the most?

Not seeing pupils and staff but also not seeing the progress made by pupils. I would love to know what all the pupils that I've taught over the years are doing now.

What are you looking forward to the most after finishing school?

Not getting up so early in the morning and not having to worry about various things such as the timetable.

Share a fact with us that we don't know about you.

When I was in primary school and the early years of secondary school, I used to have ballet lessons down in the shed near the town's rugby field. This is how I got to know Nia Bwtsh (who was a year younger than me in school. She was quite a dancer!)

Good luck Mrs Davies and thank you for all your hard work and care over the years!
