## Seek parents'/ carers' views on:

- 1. How happy and safe their child is at school
- 2. How well the school communicates with them, asks for their views and addresses any concerns that they have
- 3. The effectiveness of teaching and the progress their child makes
- 4. How well the school uses homework to extend their child's learning
- 5. How well the school keeps parents informed about the progress their child is making
- 6. The range of the curriculum offer, for example opportunities to be creative or to develop physical skills
- 7. How effectively the school encourages positive attitudes to learning, such as self-assessment, collaboration and perseverance
- 8. The part parents/carers and the community play in the life of the school
- 9. The support and guidance available to pupils, for example those with special needs
- 10. The extent to which the school promotes its safeguarding culture, including how well it promotes equality, diversity, anti-bullying and respect for others
- 11. Other issues identified by the lead inspector e.g., from the analysis of the parent/carer and pupil questionnaires
